Personal Data Processing Notice, pursuant to Articles 13-14 of EU Regulation 2016/679

Data Subjects: Data Subject - Contact Form

CERDOMUS S.R.L., in its capacity as Data Controller of your personal data, pursuant to and for the purposes of EU Regulation 2016/679, hereinafter the GDPR, hereby informs you that the aforementioned legislation provides for the protection of data subjects with respect to the processing of personal data, and that such processing rests on principles of fairness, lawfulness, transparency and the protection of your privacy and your rights.

Your personal data will be processed in accordance with the legislative provisions of the above-mentioned regulation and the confidentiality obligations set forth therein.

At the time of processing, the Data Controller may handle categories of common personal data and, more specifically: name, address or other personal ID information.

Purpose and legal basis of processing: your data will be used for the following purposes relating to the compliance with measures connected to contractual or pre-contractual requirements:

- Management of contract and contractual and pre-contractual measures adopted upon request (e.g., contact request via online forms).

Processing methods. Your personal data may be processed by:

- processing by means of electronic calculators.

All processing takes place in compliance with the methods set out in Articles 6 and 32 of the GDPR, and through the adoption of the appropriate security measures provided for.

Your data will be processed only by personnel expressly authorised by the Data Controller and, more specifically, by the following categories of authorised personnel:

- Employees of corporate departments responsible for pursuing the purposes indicated above, expressly authorised to process and who have been provided with adequate operating instructions.

Communication: your data may be shared with external parties for the correct management of contract terms, and, in particular, to the following categories of Recipients, including all duly appointed Data Processors:

- subcontractors.

Dissemination: Your personal data will not be disclosed in any way.

Your personal data may also be transferred, limited to the purposes indicated above, to the following countries:

- United States for sending emails and newsletters through the Mailchimp communication platform.

Retention Period. In compliance with the principles of lawfulness, purpose limitation and data minimisation, pursuant to Art. 5 of the GDPR, your data will be stored for:

- a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which data are collected and processed in order to manage and fulfil contract requirements;

You have the right to request from the Data Controller the deletion (right to be forgotten), limited processing, update, rectification and portability of your data, as well as to object to their processing, and, more in general, to exercise all the rights provided for by Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 of the GDPR.

EU Regulation 2016/679: Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 - Rights of Data Subject

1. Data Subjects have the right to receive confirmation of the existence or lack thereof, of their personal data, even yet to be registered, their provision in an intelligible form and to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority.

2. Data Subjects have the right to obtain information on:

- a. origin of personal data;
- b. purposes and methods of processing;
- c. logic applied in case of processing performed with the aid of electronic instruments;
- d. identifying details of Data Controller, Data Processors and any of their designated representative(s), pursuant to Article 5, paragraph 2;
- e. subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated, or who may become aware of them in their capacity as designated representative in Italy, as well as processors or persons in charge.

3. Data Subjects have the right to:

- a. have data updated, amended or supplemented, as warranted;
- b. have data deleted, anonymised or blocked, when processed in violation of the law, to include data whose retention is not necessary in relation to the purposes for which such data were collected or processed;
- c. receive a certification that the operations referred to in letters a) and b) have been brought to the attention, also with regard to their content, of those to whom the data have been provided or disclosed, except in the case in which such fulfillment proves impossible or involves the use of means manifestly disproportionate to the right protected;
- d. have their data in portable form.

4. Data Subjects have the right to object, in whole or in part:

- a. for legitimate reasons, to the processing of their personal data, even if pertinent to the purpose of the collection;
- b. to the processing of their personal data for the purpose of sending advertising or direct sales material, or for conducting market research or for commercial communication.
